Contributions/ Achievements:

- Soon after completion of my B.V.Sc., course, joined with Franco-Indian Biologicals Pvt, Ltd., Bombay as a Veterinarian and worked in Slaughterhouse, Kachiguda, Hyderabad for a short period (01-04-1981 to 25-12-1981) to the best satisfaction of the Company and received an appreciation letter from them.
- Then joined the Department of Animal Husbandry, A.P as Veterinary Assistant Surgeon on 27-12-1981 at Veterinary Dispensary, Gaddipally, Nalgonda. I tried to provide the veterinary services to the best satisfaction of farmers. In addition, I had also associated with Sri Aurobindo Institute of Rural Development, Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Gaddipally, in implementation of Animal Husbandry activities and encouraged the farmers for Rabbit rearing, piggery and Dairy farming under “Lab to Land” Programme.
- As a Veterinarian at VPC, Nalgonda performed several minor/major operations in large animals, sheep & goats and pets. I was also instrumental in construction of “theatre complex” in VPC, Nalgonda.

- As Veterinarian, at Veterinary Hospital, Malakpet, Hyderabad in addition to veterinary services to the best satisfaction of dairy farmers and also pet owners. I had the privilege of imparting training to the B.V.Sc., internees to their best satisfaction.
