		II. As a Constituency special officer: I worked as a Special Monitoring officer in Mudhole Constituency for Government flagship programme " Palle Pragathi" and visited many villages and educated and motivated the villagers and local public representatives like Sarpanch, MPTC, ward members regarding sanitation, plantation, literacy rate, health and hygiene ,Construction of toilets etc., .

- III. As a special officer for Pattana Pragathi: I also worked as a Special Monitoring officer in Nirmal Municipality for Government flagship programme "Pattana Pragathi" and visited 5 Wards and educated the public and local public representatives like ward counsellors regarding sanitation, plantation, health and hygiene, eradication of plastic etc., .
- **IV. COVID-19 Containment area special officer:** As per the District Collector orders I worked as special officer in Covid -19 containment area for a period of 2 months. During that time I distributed vegetables, rice and essential commodities to the public and monitored social distancing, given counselling to covid affected families
- V. Nodal Officer for Fish and prawns seedlings release in Reservoirs and Major Tanks: My working place Nirmal is very nearer to Sri Ram Sagar Project. Many number of fishermen depend on this project and I am appointed as Nodal officer for Fish seedlings and prawns released into SRSP check dams, Swarna Project and local water bodies. This program is inaugurated by Sri. Talasani Srinivas Yadav, Honourable Minister of Animal HUsbandry & Fisheries and Dr.M. Laxma Reddy, Director of Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Department. Under this program we have introduced near about 60 lakhs fish and prawn seedlings were introduced into the water bodies.
- **VI. E-office:** To minimise stationary usage and transparency, Nirmal District collector innovatively started e-office program from April 2020 onwards and which drastically reduces the usage of paper. In this system we have to submit all files in specially created district portal and we can get the authorization through that portal only with digital signature provided to each and every section. With minimum technical staff in my department i.e., Veterinary and Animal Husbandry Department stood second position after Revenue department among all other departments in the district.
- **VII. Construction of compound wall and Gate:** As a District officer maintaining sound communication and association with District Collector succeeded in sanction of Rs. 3 Lakhs for construction of collapsed compound wall and gate which were neglected from past 10 years and completed the compound wall and gate with new look .
- **VIII. Haritha Haram In DVAHO office:** We have planted more than 800 plants in office premises with 100% survival rate which includes flowering, fruit bearing and shady plants and medicinal plants with drip system without asking any budget from any department with my personal interest in addition perineal fodder plot and stylohemata fodder plot.

IX. ESTABLISHMENT OF MRCC CENTRE IN NIRMAL: First of its kind, We have established Monkey Rescue and Rehabilitation Centre in Nirmal district and conducting Vasectomy and tubectomy to the caught monkeys through laparoscopic method in coordination with forest department to minimise the monkey manace in all the villages of Nirmal district Primarily then after to nearby districts. This rehabilitation centre is second in India and first in South India. After taking over my charge as DVAHO, Nirmal, I have send the 2 VASs and one para vet for training at Simla of Himachal Pradesh and got handful training and recently started the centre by the Honarable Forest Minister Sri.Indra Karan Reddy garu on 20.12.2020. With the help of Principal secretary madam and Director of Animal Husbandry, one VAS and one paravet got deputation to the MRCC.

X. Worked as Returning officer, Basar for Zilla Parishad Territorial Constituency members and conducted elections successfully.

Remarks: All these Programmes have been perfectly planned, supervised and monitored and implemented successfully in Nirmal district in coordination with the field staff. The relevant reports are enclosed herewith for kind perusal.
